

Middleton Conservation Committee Minutes

Regular Meeting,
February 13, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 10:15 am.

Tom Gardner, Nicole Ramone, Kim Murphy and Carol Vita were present.

The minutes of the January meeting were read and approved.

First item on the agenda was the milfoil project. John Mullen explained to us that the Selectmen would concu with the information provided by Solitude Lake Management once we had signed the contract. The Commission members voted to approve the herbicide chemical treatment to remove the milfoil from the lake. As far as we know, eight other lakes have used this chemical and it seems to be working. It should keep the Milfoil from growing in the lake for approximately 2 years and would save multiple diving costs that we are paying right now. The cost for this will be \$14,090.00. DES will give us a grant for \$4,000.

Tom Gardner said that he got an email from Emily Lord, pertaining to an easement in Tanglewood.

John Mullen told us to watch out for Sino bacteria in the lake.

The state usually does a chemical check at Sunrise Lake once a year.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:05.
