January 21, 2021

New Business:

- **Sunrise Lake Watershed Plan** C. Vita and J. Mullen shared information on the Sunrise Lake Watershed Plan managed by Strafford Regional Planning Commission. The study will take till late fall to complete and will include members from the community, town and state officials. The purpose is to look at the lake's status and quality level, collect data from federal, state and local resources and to map out a strategy to at least maintain the current quality standards. An information announcement to the residents will be forth coming in the next few weeks.
- **Blueberry Hill Property:** General discussion on where the property was located, owner ship history etc. and potential use of the property. C. Kimball made contact with the Strafford County forester who would be willing to visit the property to provide and overview of its state. The visit will be scheduled with in the next few weeks. J. Mullen will provide details of the property including map and lot numbers as well as location. Further discuss will be conducted on the position the Commission will take on its use now and in the future.
