

Meeting called to order at 12:57pm

Roll Call: Christine Maynard, Roxanne Tufts-Keegan

At 12:58pm, Roxanne motioned to go into Nonpublic session RSA 91-A:3, II (b). Christine seconded the motion. Roxanne stated yes and Christine stated yes.

Roxanne and Christine conducted interviews.

Roxanne and Christine discussed each of the applicants.

Roxanne made a motion to recommend offering the Code Enforcement/Health officer position to Carl Roy at the rate of \$5,600/annually and to renegotiate the pay once he is certified. Christine seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Roxanne made a motion to recommend offering the Admin Assistant/bookkeeper position to Kathryn Toussaint at the rate of \$20/hour and to be evaluated at the end of 90 days. At that time, the BOS will determine if the pay should be increased to \$21/hour. Christine seconded the motion. The motion passed.

At 2:50 pm, Roxanne motioned to end the Nonpublic session RSA 91-A:3, II (b). Christine seconded the motion. Roxanne stated yes and Christine stated yes.

Roxanne motion to adjourn (2:51pm). Christine seconded the motion. The motion carried.

On October 29, 2021 the Governor's Office for Emergency Relief and Recovery (GOFERR) opened the applications for the Locality Equipment Matching Program which provides support of up to \$50,000 per New Hampshire locality (cities and towns) for 90% of the purchase price of safety and emergency equipment needed as a result of or in response to the health crisis and its negative effects.

GOFERR records indicate that your locality either has not yet applied or has a remaining balance for which it could submit an additional application. This is a reminder that, although localities will have until December 31, 2022, to purchase the approved equipment, applications must be submitted **no later than June 3, 2022**.
