Meeting was called to order at 10:08 am

Carol Vita, Kimberly Murphy, Nicole Rainone, and John Mullen were present.

Town offered for us to buy two lots of land to make them conservation land. (Elaine Dr 4-178 & a lot on John Jones. After researching locations we declined.

John Mullen is going to out together a letter to send out to the current owners of the plots in tanglewood suggesting they gift them to the town for tax right off. After we get responses we will evaluate which ones we would be interested in purchasing.

There was a unanimous vote to change Meeting times to 4:00pm for July and August due to summer schedules.
