Board of Selectmen Department Head Minutes

1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Roxanne Tufts-Keegan – Chair
2. **Pledge of Allegiance**
3. **Roll Call:** Roxanne Tufts-Keegan-Chair, Bonnie Gagnon-Vice Chair, Tim Cremmen-Member, Mike Green-Member and Jonathan Sindorf-Member
4. **Approval of minutes:** The minutes for April 6, 2026 was requested by Tim Cremmen to table so that he has had time to review them.

New Business

5. **Emergency Management:** no reports or updates submitted.
6. **Fire/EMS:** no reports submitted.
7. **Highway Dept:** Dan Phillips, road agent, reviewed the work done by the highway department for the period covering March 10, 2026 to April 13, 2026. Attached is the list of work. Dan stated at the end of his review, that if anyone has any questions to call at 603-473-5229, email the highway dept at roadagent@middletonnh.gov or the Board of Selectmen at bos@middletonnh.gov. Dan also mentioned that as of Thursday April 16, 2026 the weight limit postings for the roads will be lifted. Dan has reminded homeowners that they are responsible for the cleanout of the culverts on their driveways. Tim Cremmen stated it was great to have Dan back to the meetings and would like to “Thank” the highway department for all their hard work they have been doing and heads up about the roads not being posted anymore. Tim will have this posted on our website.
8. **Police department:** Chief Ferguson reviewed the month of March. Attached is his report and here are some of the highlights. The Strafford County dispatch has had calls in regard to the roads being posted as well as the Police department. This information will be uploaded to the website. The PD have stopped a few of the big trucks that were over the weight limits on posted roads. Littering, there is a fine for littering in the amount of \$288.00. PD will not be giving out warnings, if you are caught throwing trash out of your vehicle, you will be fined. CPR/AED training is on April 24, 2026 for employees. Bike helmets for the children will be picked up this week. The Police will be working with the school to coordinate with the slow down Middleton on June 16, 2026. There will be a clean up day on April 26th. The PD and Highway have blue bags and gloves for people to pick up if they would like to donate their time and help clean up our town. Just tie up the bags and leave on the side of the road and highway will pick them up and dispose in the Town’s dumpsters. There is a gentleman on Silver Street that has picked up trash and had about 8-10 bags. Thank you. We have a mountain bike and have had it assessed to get it back up and going and potentially this summer. Have been working with Code Enforcement on multiple code violations in town. Some properties have been cleaned up. This will take time to

Bonnie Gagnon stated she was contacted by a school group of about 30 kids that would like to help with the cleaning up trash. Bonnie also wanted to say thank you to the rec team and all the others that helped stuff over 3,000 eggs. The recreation committee is having a craft fair on May 16th from 11:00 to 4:00. There are already over 50 vendors signed up. Bonnie wanted to say thank you to Roxanne, Roy and Susan for all the hard work done at the Municipal building. There may be another scout that is going for his eagle merits. The Eagle Scout ceremony that was held at the old town hall went very well. Now his younger brother is going through the process. His mother has a few ideas. They mentioned the sign at the municipal building is not in the best of shape. Maybe there are some ideas we can come up with.

17. **Public comments:** Jim Keegan would like to thank the police department for the extra heavy-duty control on all the roads. If the Highway department saw some large trucks on the roads, they would call Chief Ferguson and they would go and take care of it.

Recommended Old Town Hall Maintenance and Repairs

Comprehensive Needs Assessment and Future Planning

Overview

Since the completion of the Old Town Restoration, the Town has done an exemplary job maintaining the building. The main hall, kitchen, bathrooms, and hallway remain in excellent condition after years of use. Improvements such as installing a drainage system and paving the driveway have significantly reduced water damage due to poor drainage. Essential repairs, including replacing some of the Chapel's window glass, have helped keep the building protected from the elements. Regular cleaning, including attention to the bathrooms, has helped preserve the building's beauty and cleanliness over time.

However, to ensure the building remains accessible and safe for resident use in the future, it is necessary to address several additional maintenance and repair needs.

Current Needs

1. There is a suspected roof leak above the Bathroom Hallway. This issue requires immediate attention to prevent further damage. Cost TBD. (Fig. 1)
2. The return air duct of the heating system should be cleaned, and a 16x32x2 filter should be fitted and replaced regularly. The cost of a filter is approximately \$20. Fig. 2)
3. A permanent two-level step with railings should be installed at the front door. The current ramp poses a significant hazard to residents, particularly during the winter months, both when entering and exiting the building. Cost TBD. (Fig. 3)
4. The Utilities Room needs to be organized, and the door should be reversed for safer operation. Clutter and disorganization currently present a hazard for accessing the electrical panel, security system, and Water System. Cost TBD plus volunteer assistance. (Fig. 4)
5. The wooden clap siding on the front, south, and east sides of the building should be repaired to prevent water intrusion and structural damage. The south side exhibits the most deterioration. Damaged siding on the east side allows water to enter a window during heavy rain, spilling into the Main Hall. The area next to and above the kitchen on the east side is deteriorating quickly. Cost TBD(Figs. 5,6,7)
6. General cleaning of the Chapel is needed to maintain its condition. The cost of cleaning would be provided by volunteer assistance.
7. All floors throughout the building should be washed and waxed to preserve their appearance and longevity. The cost of materials would be \$50, with application provided by volunteer assistance. (Fig. 8)

8. The step to the Fire Department Office should be updated to improve safety and accessibility. Cost TBD. (Fig. 9)
9. A permanent step should be installed at the other front exit to improve safe exit and access. Cost TBD (Fig. 10)
10. The second-floor window shades need to be replaced. They include nine 36x64 and four 30x64 cordless shades. The purchase cost for the blinds would be approximately \$175. Installation would be provided by Volunteer assistance. (Fig. 11)
11. Install the Donor's Plaque inside the Hall. (Fig.12)

Future Considerations

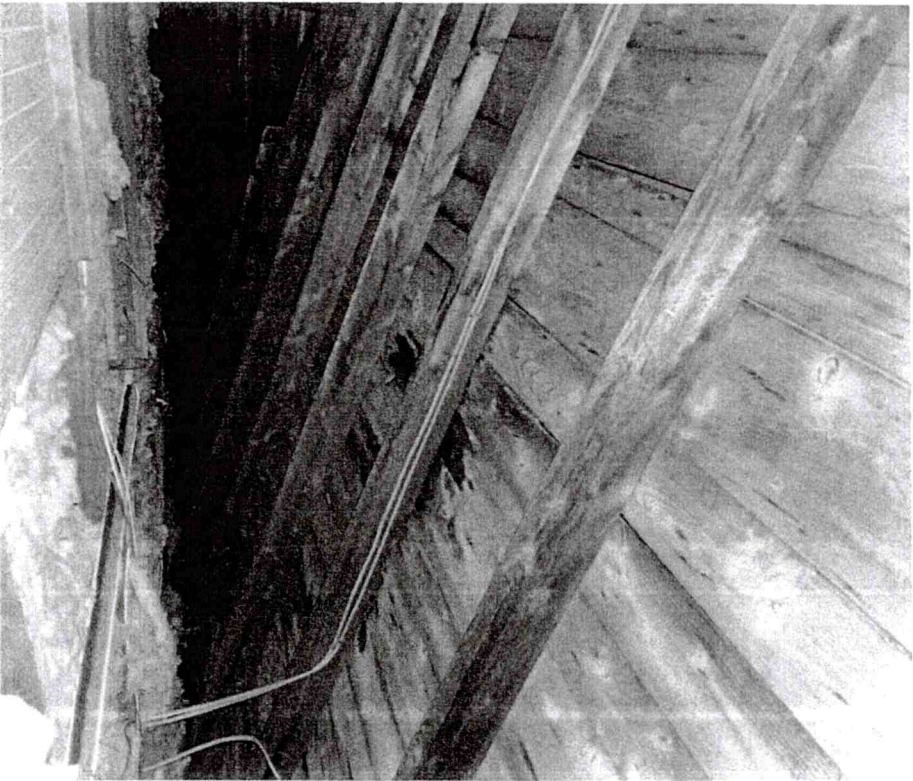
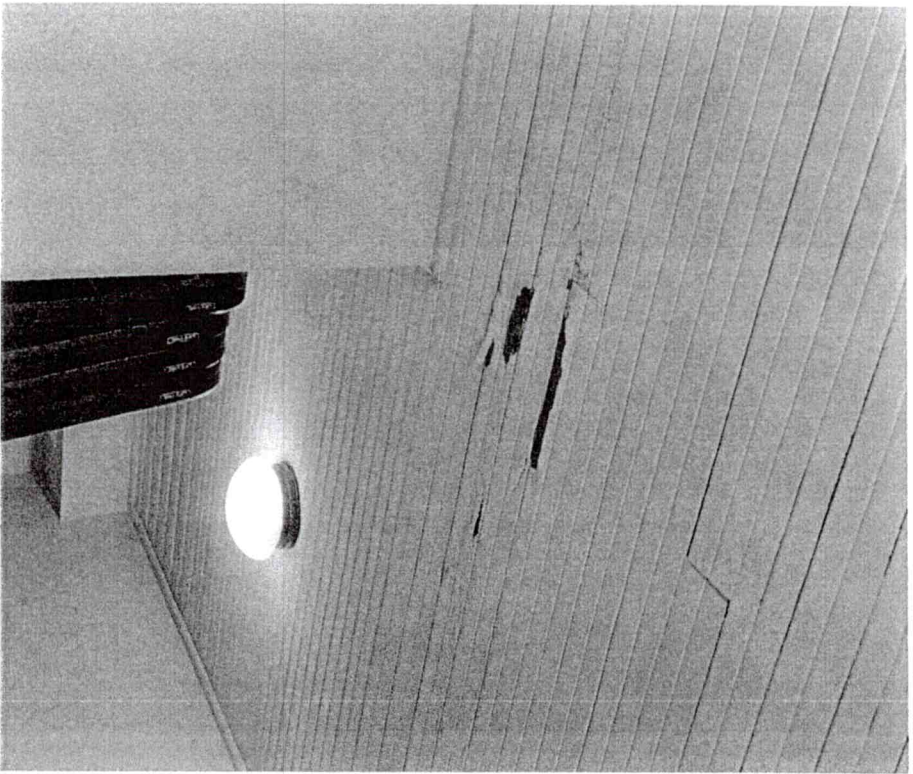
1. Investigate grant funding to refurbish the thirteen second-floor windows. The estimated cost for each window ranges from \$300 to \$600 or more.
2. The range should be replaced, as it is old and requires special attention when operating. It could pose a safety and fire hazard. A new 60" gas range is expected to cost between \$1,800 and \$3,000, including installation.
3. Exterior painting of the building should be completed to protect and enhance its appearance.
4. Installation of a new energy-efficient, quieter furnace is recommended. The price installed could range from \$5,000 to \$10,000.
5. If not already arranged, an annual service contract for the furnace and the hot water system should be established to ensure continued reliable operation.

Ongoing Maintenance

In addition to the specific action items listed above, it is essential to implement regular maintenance schedules to inspect the exterior and interior of the building. Monitoring for minor cracks or wear can help prevent more costly repairs in the future. By proactively addressing maintenance needs and maintaining a commitment to ongoing care, the Old Town Hall will continue to serve residents as a safe, welcoming, and functional community space for many years to come.

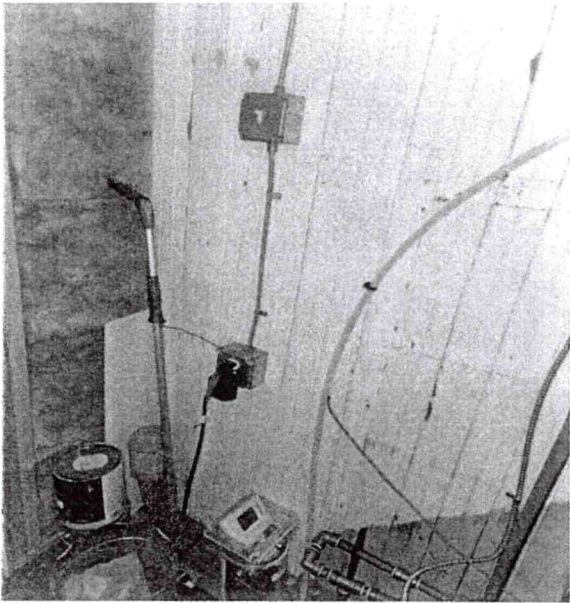

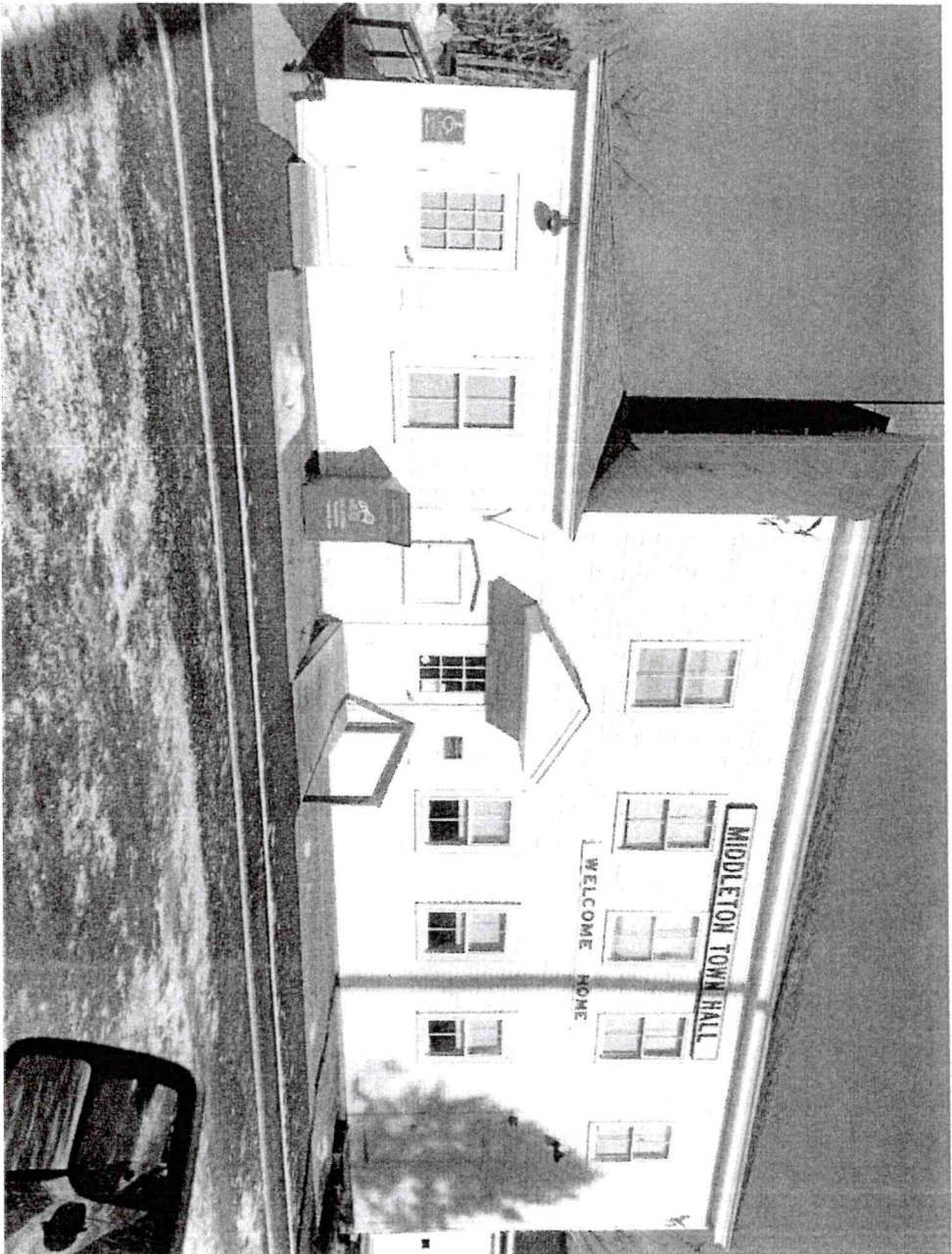

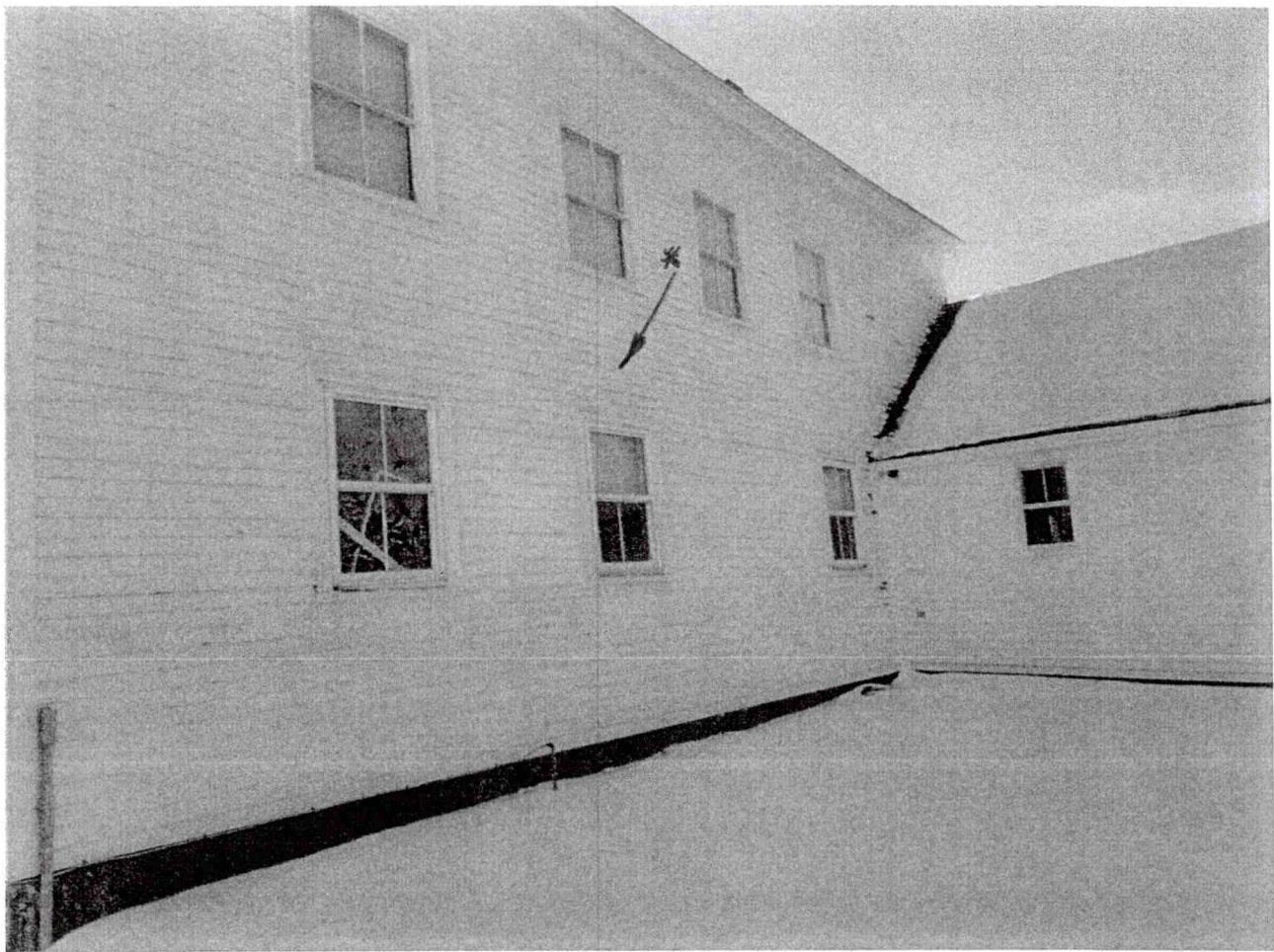

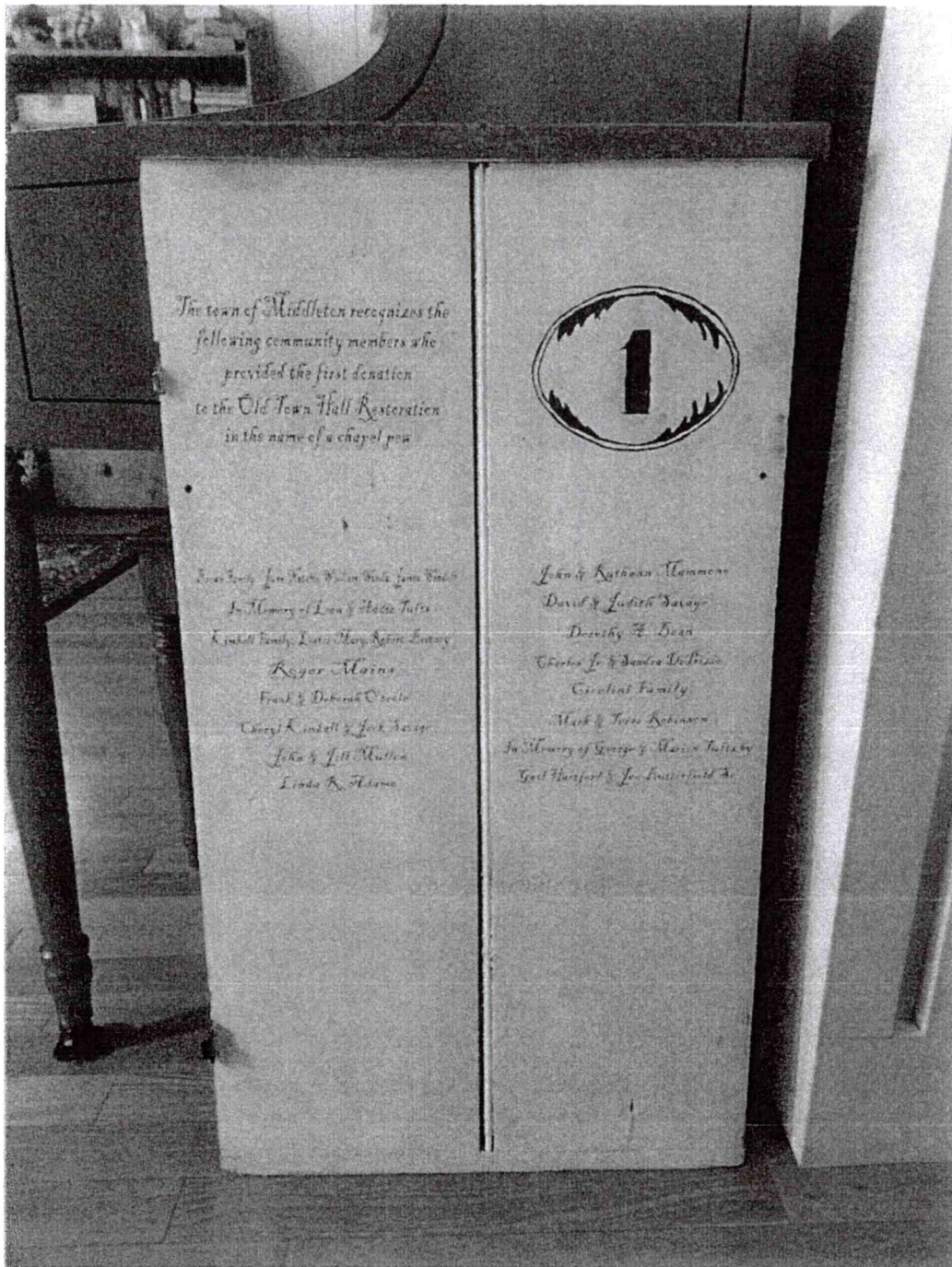

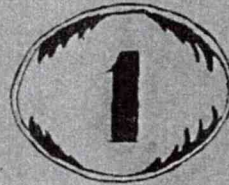
Front Hall Exit
