Minutes

Friday, July 10, 2026, at 6:00pm, Old Town Hall

Public Hearing was called to order by R. Tufts-Keegan at 6:00PM.

Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call:

The following board members present were Tim Cremmen - member; Roxanne Tufts-Keegan - chair; Bonnie Gagnon – vice-chair.

R. Tufts-Keegan stated the public hearing was for the upcoming Special Town meeting that would be held on July 18, 2026, at 9:00AM at the OTH for the townspeople to vote on the following: “Shall the Town vote to cure the procedurally defective Articles 7-16 for the 2026 Annual Town meeting?”. She explained articles 7-16 should have been by voted on by ballot vote and not voice vote since the town has a tax cap. She stated that articles 7-16 total an amount of \$593,036 and this is mostly made up of article 7, which covers solid waste collection and article 9 which covers Road reconstruction/paving. The remaining articles are for Highway Department Vehicle Capital Reserve fund, Reevaluation Capital Reserve fund, Self-contained Breathing Apparatus Capital Reserve fund, Natural or Man-made Disasters Capital Reserve fund, Fire Department Replacement Capital Reserve fund, Public Safety Complex Capital Reserve fund, and Medical Equipment Capital Reserve fund.

A resident asked if the town would be voting on articles 7-16 again and R. Tufts-Keegan stated that the upcoming voting was to address the procedural

defect in how the articles were voted on and not the articles themselves. She stated that there would be only one special warrant article and it would be voted on by ballot vote. She stated that in order for the vote to pass it would require 3/5 ballot vote.

No further discussion was had.

B. Gagnon motioned to adjourn at 6:08PM. T. Cremmen seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.
