

Pledge Recited

Roll Call- present. J. Hotchkiss, J. Bailey, excused- J. Mullen Jr.

Signature Action:

- *J. Bailey motions to accept the BOS minutes from 02/25/2019 as written. J. Hotchkiss seconds. All in favor.*
- *Five abatements presented from Kathleen Bailey. First for 348 Ridge Road. J. Hotchkiss read aloud the recommendation from Avitar. This abatement was denied by Avitar. Second abatement was for 17 Spruce Road. This abatement was also denied by Avitar. Third abatement was for 154 Lakeshore Drive. This abatement was also denied by Avitar. Fourth abatement was for the property located at 122 Deer Run Road. This abatement as well was denied by Avitar. Fifth abatement was for an elderly tax exemption that was denied at a previous meeting and needs to be signed by the Board of Selectmen. Kathleen Blaney makes all aware that liens have gone out and lien date is April 15th at 12:00 PM and deed date is May 30th.*
