7. Highway Dept

Minutes:

Dan Phillips Road Agent reported the following for Feb 13th thru Mar 11th. Greased front ends & chasis of big plow trucks. Had 55 gal drums of hydroil and motor oil delivered. Checked the pump at Old Town Hall which they do every Wednesday. Checked on New Durham Road driveway with no permit. They obtained a permit all set now. Plowed and treated storm on 2/16 2 inches, 2/23 less than 1 inch and 2/29 icy roads. Fix plow hose truck #1. Put new fuel tank on #22 . Washed trucks & sanders. Swapped out wing block truck #24 broken spring. Back drag & raked dirt roads. Weld on loader bucket, normal wear. Put up Posted signs. Checked roads after wind storm for limbs. Check culverts after rain. Home owners are responsible for cleaning out debris in culverts. Cut up & chipped brush down tree on Kings Highway big pine.

8. Fire/EMS

Minutes:

Chief Michael Laviolette stated: For the month of February 2924 Middleton Fire & Rescue had 19 calls. 9 fire calls that from ALock outs to medical assist. There were 10 medical emergencies, of which 2 were covered by us. In February we trained on ice water rescues.
