

Hotchkiss also ask, "If it does go are, we going still have an issue with water down in that area"? J. Knapp states that its wet and muddy. The company that came in and prepared the site did not do a good job. J. Varga states it does not look any rhyme or reason why they did what they did on that site. J. Knapp states the next step for Jones and Beach is to do a test site. J. Knapp states we are spending more in engineering also. J. Varga ask if this site is going to cost more money then we need to stop and re assess. J. Hotchkiss states with the concern of all of this, should we spend the 175,000 for the salt shed. We have spent some money out of it.

Before June 1st Relief Cares Act Fund is due for signing the agreement. J. Hotchkiss states he will work on that this week and send it in. Also, Kathleen Blaney and Chief Cooper is working on the reimbursement side that is due June 1st for the months of March and April 30th. J. Varga states that we need to be on top of it.

J. Hotchkiss states that we should be able to control the website , J. Varga states that a company will run the website .
