

Old Business:

Janet Kalar states certified letter went out today to Eric Knapp regarding fence. Peter Cicolini was reached out to in regards Eric Knapp doing his own electrical work for pool. Peter Cicolini states home owners can do their own electrical as long as they have an inspection done as well.

Salt Shed – Put out to bid. Jones and Beach will call us 8/31 with a two part bid, dirt work/concrete and the other is roof/building. Jones and Beach are not approving or disapproving of any bids received for salt shed, that is solely up to the Board of Selectmen. J. Hotchkiss states anticipating salt shed to be ready to use before winter.

Phone installations are scheduled for September 9th.

New Business

John Mullen states picked up milfoil over near Pinkham Cove. The State has called Bob Patterson to do a dive and remove milfoil.

Roxanne Tufts-Keegan, from the budget committee, asks John Mullen if there is a problem with using the OTH for profit. John Mullen states he believes that was written in the rules, but can be changed by current board.

John Mullen states residents on Lakeshore reported a heavy "fish" kill. States he talked with fish and game and was advised this is happening all over the state due to warm waters. John Mullen also stated that the eagles are most likely taking the bigger fish and dropping them back into the lake.

John Mullen states no hearing is needed on changing the rules in regards to the use of the OTH. States that if the board chooses to allow for profit use then they should consider having a bond or liability clause as a requirement.
