## **NOTICE OF DECISION - GRANTED**

You are hereby notified that the appeal of PL Gagnon Family Trust, Paul G. and Lucia L. Gagnon Trustees for a variance regarding Article 5, Section B3 of the zoning ordinance has been **GRANTED**, subject to the conditions listed below, by the affirmative vote of at least three members of the Zoning Board of Adjustment.

## Findings of fact:

## Summary of the facts of the case discussed at the above public hearing:

- 1. The garage will not be contrary to the public interest as it would not have any negative impact on the neighborhood that would alter its essential character. It will not impede any right of way, view, or access to the lake.
- 2. The spirit of the ordinance is observed. The garage will not pose a risk to public health, safety and welfare.
- 3. Substantial justice exists as denying this variance and requiring the garage at the standard setback would not be possible given the area of the nonconforming lot. It would also prevent the applicant from being able to have the garage with no gain to the public.
- 4. The value of surrounding properties will not be diminished because they are not negatively affected by the proposed placement of the garage.
- 5. The property cannot be used in strict conformity with the setback required by the ordinance for the structure without causing harm to the property owner in that he would need to tear down the existing structure and not be able to re-build.
