Instructions for Permit Applications:

1. All information must be printed legibly.
2. Owner name, mailing address and phone number.
3. Location and address of work site.
4. Complete description of work to be done.
5. Number of fixtures, appliances and equipment to be installed.
6. Plans must be submitted on all new buildings and major renovations.

Notes:

The burden for compliance with all applicable building codes, city ordinances and State laws rest solely upon the property owner and his/her agent. Plans must be submitted to the Middleton Code Enforcement Department for approval. Special Inspection Escrow Accounts are required for some projects. Please inquire at the Code Office.

It is the responsibility of all contractors, electricians and plumbers to obtain the necessary permits from the Code Enforcement Office at the Municipal Building before ANY work has begun. Work must begin within six (6) months of the issuance of any permit.

Contractors must have a valid license from the State of New Hampshire to obtain a permit. Permits are not transferable.

It is the responsibility of the contractor to obtain all inspections required. A rough-in inspection is required before any work is covered, and a final inspection is required when all work is complete. A Notice is required for any inspection. *This signed application constitutes consent on the applicant's part to allow for all inspections at the property location listed.*

No permit will be issued until all of the above information is furnished, and all the above conditions are met.

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED: (Please provide 48 hour notice)

1. When job is complete, and system under pressure.

Code Enforcement Approval would certify that the applicant could proceed with installation of plumbing fixtures in accordance with specifications submitted. Any deviation from the specifications submitted will require an amendment to this permit or additional permits.
